

Grammy Award Winner QUIQUE SINESI will be performing at The Linda on Saturday, September 17th at 8.00 PM.

Considered one of the most important guitarists from Argentina, his music incorporates elements of folk, tango, jazz and classical contemporary styles. He has performed extensively in Argentina, South America, Europe and Japan. He has toured USA and Canada on several occasions.

He has interpreted the music of folk composers, such as Cuchi Leguizamon and traditional tangos, as well as his own compositions. His music is performed and recorded by other world renown guitarist such as Sharon Isbin, Berta Rojas and Stanley Jordan.

He has performed and recorded with jazz stars Paquito de Rivera, Joe Lovano, saxophonist Charlie Mariano and flutist Hikaru Iwakawa. His work with Pablo Ziegler (Astor Piazzolla's former pianist) led to several recordings and a Grammy Award in 2006.

The event will include performances by Harry Pellegrin and Matthew Downey, members of the Classical Guitar Society of Upstate New York.
